## GEMS FirstPoint School Uniform Expectations 2023-2024

At GEMS FirstPoint School we take great pride in the appearance of our students. This document outlines the uniform expectations for all students in the school. As part of the Parent/School Contract, all parents agree to provide their child(ren) with a full school uniform (including correct formal footwear – please read page 5). On days where students have PE they must wear full uniform to school and then change into their PE kit at the start of the lesson. Please note that if a student is seen to not be following the school uniform policy, they may be removed from circulation until the uniform is rectified. In these instances, parents will be contacted in order to support the school and ensure their child is in full school uniform. In extreme cases, parents may be asked to collect their child from school.

## Year 7 - 11 Visual

### Male Student

A professional haircut; natural colour and no extreme styles.

Hair must be professional with no extreme/unnatural colours or lines shaved in.

A blue shirt with embroidered school logo.  
Shirt to always be tucked in, top button securely fastened.

A FPS tie must be always worn.

A wristwatch can be worn but no other jewellery permitted for both Male/Female students.

A plain black belt can be worn.

Formal Navy trousers.

Plain black formal shoes as per below policy.



### Female Student

Hair must be professional with no extreme/unnatural colours. Tied back where appropriate.

A small single stud in each ear is permitted only.

A blue shirt with embroidered school logo.  
Shirt to be tucked in at all times, top button securely fastened.

An FPS tie must be worn at all times.

Nail varnish is not permitted.

Formal Navy trousers or Navy skirt that must be below the knee.

Plain black formal shoes as per below policy.



All shoes must be formal; plain black leather polishable shoes.  
No canvas, fabric, pump or sport-shoe/trainer style or brand.  
(Regardless if black leather)





## Year 12 - 13 Visual

A professional haircut; natural colour and no extreme styles.

### Male Student

Hair must be professional with no extreme/unnatural colours or lines shaved in.

A plain white shirt, no logos. Shirt to be always tucked in, top button securely fastened.

A plain tie must be always worn. (Optional for female)

A wristwatch can be worn but no other jewellery permitted for both Male/Female students.

A plain black belt can be worn.

Plain formal black suit trousers. (No jeans/chinos)

Plain black formal shoes as per below policy.



### Female Student

Hair must be professional with no extreme/unnatural colours. Tied back where appropriate.

A plain black, white, navy lure headscarf.

A small single stud in each ear is permitted only.

A plain white blouse/shirt. Shirt to be tucked in at all times, top button securely fastened.

Optional plain black cardigan/jumper can be worn. (No logos/hoodies/zip ups)

Nail varnish is not permitted.

Formal Black trousers or Black skirt that must be below the knee.

Plain black formal shoes as per below policy.



All shoes must be formal; plain black leather polishable shoes. No canvas, fabric, pump or sport-shoe/trainer style or brand. (Regardless if black leather)

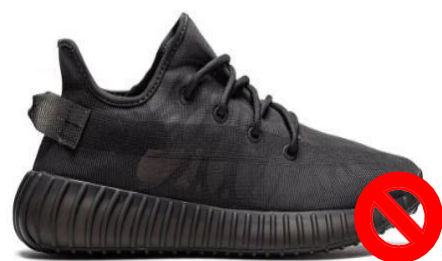




## Prohibited Footwear
