## Visas

Visas are the sole responsibility of the parent. Please ensure you check visa processing times for your child's passport and apply for these in good time prior to the trip. Any documents you require in order to apply for your visa can be supplied by the school or the travel company once initial deposits have been paid and flights confirmed. Please liaise directly with the trip lead.

## Trip cost

Trip costs are based on a minimum number of students attending. In some cases, trip costs may change if there are fewer students signed up to the trip. Any changes in cost will be communicated to parents by the trip lead. Unless otherwise specified, trip cost includes: Flights, accommodation, insurance, meals, transfers and activities listed on itinerary.
