As part of the Parent/School Contract, all parents agree to provide their child(ren) with a full school uniform (including correct footwear). On days where students have PE they must wear full uniform to school and then change into their PE kit at the start of the lesson.

Optional FPS logo cardigan/pullover/jacket to be worn over shirt

A wristwatch can be worn but no other jewellery permitted for both Male/Female students.

A plain black belt can be worn.

Formal Navy trousers.

Plain black formal shoes as per below policy.



Female Student

Hair must be professional with no extreme/unnatural colours. Tied back where appropriate.

A small single stud in each ear is permitted only. **No other jewellery permitted**

A blue shirt with embroidered school logo.

Optional FPS logo cardigan/pullover/jacket to be worn over shirt

Nail varnish is not permitted.

Formal Navy trousers or Navy skirt that **must be below the knee.**

Plain black formal shoes as per below policy.



All-black low footwear, either shoes or trainers.
No hi-tops, platform or coloured markings on the shoes

Female Student

Hair must be professional with no extreme/unnatural colours. Tied back where appropriate.

A plain black,white, navy lure headscarf.

A small single stud in each ear. **No other jewellery is permitted**

FPS logo white blouse/shirt.

Plain black non logo cardigan/pullover/jacket, if worn, shirt must be tucked in

Nail varnish is not permitted.

Formal Black trousers or Black skirt that must be below the knee.

Plain black formal shoes as per below policy.

All-black low footwear, either shoes or trainers.
No hi-tops, platform or coloured markings on the shoes

Sanctions for noncompliance with the policy

We understand there may be issues with supply and demand regarding the new FPS uniform updates, and we are committed to supporting families in this transition. However, it is the parents' responsibility to communicate with the school about any delays in obtaining the required uniform. Parents must provide written confirmation to their child's form tutor indicating the earliest possible date for obtaining the uniform. If this date passes and the student is still not in the correct uniform, they will be removed from circulation, and parents will be contacted to bring the appropriate attire. If this is not possible, the student will be removed from circulation until the uniform is rectified

Hygiene and sanitising products

Food Preparation and Nutrition: Students are expected to bring their ingredients for practical lessons to school already weighed and measured. If students are unable to weigh and measure at home, they can do this in school in the morning of their practical lesson between 7:15-7:30am. All ingredients should be put in to reasonable sized containers or bags that clearly show the student's name. All ingredients that need to be in the fridge for health and safety purposes should be put there before the start of the school day, there is a storage trolley for any remaining ingredients. A suitable sized container should also be brought in to school in order to take the finished product home.
